#### Fun and physical requirements:

Scoring is not only used to create statistics but is a necessary requirement for a match to be played in an organized manner in accordance with the rules. The scorer creates the official match report sheet for the DBV, there he/she notes all used players, so that their eligibility can be checked by the DBV. He/she is responsible for documenting the course of the game, for this he/she counts runs and notes all player changes, determines the official final score, creates a statistical evaluation of all offensive, defensive and pitching actions, from which a game statistic is then created. We would love to hear from anyone who is willing to learn how to do this, and we are happy to share more information with anyone interested.
